AMENDMENT OF BYLAWS

Ms. Hartoin will present a request to amend the bylaws to add Stan Antonelli III of Psychotherapy Associates in Kokomo as a voting member of the JRAC, as one of the new treatment providers for Cass County, primarily for the county's Pretrial Services and Juvenile Probation programs. This request follows the same principle used when adding the Cass County Drug and Alcohol Program Director as a voting member.

In May, Court Services Director Hillary Hartoin submitted the CY25 IOCS JPAR SIM Grant. The grant seeks to increase funding and expand the services covered. Designated funding will support the Therapeutic Division of CPCC, as well as therapeutic services for Pretrial Services and Juvenile Probation. Historically, additional funding has been awarded for competency evaluations for the Courts and EBP curriculum.

While the official award letter has not yet been received, Court Services is slated to receive \$144,000 in grant funding. They also expect an award announcement regarding the CY2025 Court Reform Grant, which would provide a new audio-visual system for Cass Superior Court 2.

In October, all local community supervision staff attended Part 2 of the Coaching Model for Change Collaborative Training, which was led by Brian Lovins of Justice System Partners and sponsored by the local JRAC. Using JPAR SIM Grant funding, Ms. Hartoin signed a contract in July to provide continued professional development with JSP and Dr. Lovins, further supporting the implementation of the Coaching Model. This technical assistance contract also allows staff to earn their Coaching Certifications from JSP through the Journey.DO software.
